DAY 1

Session 1: DefSpace Challenges: Update & Future

- A dedicated session focused on building a robust Indian defence space architecture, aligning with the national space strategy.

Session 2: China's Defence Space Capability: **Review & Strategy**

Session 4: Enabling Secure, Reliable, and Seamless Communication & PNT to support **Battlespace Requirements**

· This session addressed the need for secure and reliable communication and positioning, navigation, and timing (PNT) systems for military operations.

Session 1: Energising Comprehensive National **Capability to Support Defence Space Industry**

Session 3: Opportunities for Transcontinental Cooperation & Emerging Frameworks for Space

• Discussions covered potential areas for collaboration with other countries and the development of new frameworks for international cooperation in space.
