EUTELSAT ONEWEB

- Eutelsat Oneweb Group partnered with SoftBank to integrate their LEO connectivity services, targeting high-speed, secure communications for corporations and government clients.
- The partnership will integrate with SoftBank's "SmartVPN" for added security, initially focusing on Japan with potential expansion to other markets.
- Eutelsat OneWeb launched a new PNT service called Astra to address GPS vulnerabilities to jamming and interference in critical sectors.
- Astra utilizes alternative PNT signals, such as those from Iridium satellites, and provides a compatible output for standard GPS receivers.
- Different versions of Astra will be available for the U.S. government and allied nations, enhancing secure and resilient navigation capabilities.



SPACEFIELDS

- SpaceFields, an IISc-incubated startup, successfully tested India's first aerospike rocket engine at the IISc Propulsion Test Facility in Challakere, Chitradurga.
- The 168 mm aerospike engine achieved stable combustion after initial instability, reaching a peak thrust of 2000 Newtons with a maximum pressure of 11 bar.
- The engine delivered 54,485.9 Newton-seconds of impulse, demonstrating its efficiency across varying altitudes due to the aerospike design's adaptability to atmospheric pressure changes.



OMSPACE

- Ahmedabad-based Omspace Rocket and Exploration Pvt. Ltd. successfully conducted a hot fire test of its Infinity rocket engine.
- The Infinity launch vehicle is designed to deploy nanosatellites and microsatellites into Low Earth Orbit with an environmentally friendly fuel and rapid 24-hour relaunch capability.
- The reusable electric rocket incorporates advanced technologies like metal 3D printing, a miniaturized avionics package, and composite materials.
- Capable of placing payloads up to 800 km in orbit, the Infinity rocket offers customizable, low-cost access to space for small satellite missions.

INTELSAT

- Intelsat announced plans to provide multi-orbit solutions across its business units by mid-2025.
- The new strategy combines geostationary satellites with Low Earth Orbit partnerships to enhance capabilities and cost-effectiveness.
- Intelsat's multi-orbit services will target sectors like commercial aviation, government, and mobility applications, offering improved performance, resiliency, and flexibility.
- Strategic investments in new terminal technologies are central to this expansion, enabling reliable, high-performance connectivity across diverse applications.



KALEIDEO

- KaleidEO Space Systems, part of SatSure Analytics India, launched a new earth observation payload with optimized area coverage and high-resolution imaging.
- The payload achieves nearly 1-meter GSD while capturing a 65 km swath.
- After successful aerial testing with a prototype capturing 16 cm resolution images, the payload is tailored to industry demand for largearea imaging and scalable automated analytics.
- This approach focuses on 'Demand First', aligning payload capabilities with industry needs for efficient data acquisition and analysis.



BELLATRIX

- Bellatrix Aerospace, a Bengaluru-based startup, unveiled Project 200, an ultra-low Earth orbit (ULEO) satellite, at the Bengaluru Space Expo 2024.
- Designed to operate between 180 km and 250 km, Project 200 aims to revolutionize satellite capabilities with its innovative propulsion system.
- This technology demonstration mission will support high-resolution earth observation, telecommunications, and scientific research, offering transformative connectivity and imaging applications at ultra-low altitudes.

GALAXEYE

- Infosys announced an investment of up to Rs 17 crore (approximately \$2 million) in GalaxEye Space Solutions, an Indian Earth-observation startup, as part of its innovation Fund.
- The investment will be made through equity and Series A convertible preference shares, with Infosys acquiring a minority stake of up to 20% in GalaxEye.
- This collaboration will focus on Satellite Data Fusion, Al-driven Analytics, and next-gen space technologies, aiming to reshape space technology and earth observation applications.
- The deal is expected to close by September 30, 2024.



PIXXEL

- Pixxel became the first Indian space startup to secure a contract with NASA.
- Pixxel will supply hyperspectral earth observation data as part of NASA's \$476-million commercial smallsat data acquisition program.
- The program, running through November 2028, will support NASA, the US government, and academic partners in advancing earth science research and applications.
- This marks a major milestone for Indian private space companies since the sector opened to private entities in 2020.



ISRO AND IIG SIGN MOU FOR SCIENTIFIC COLLABORATION


Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), Department of Space, has signed an MOU with the Indian Institute of Geomagnetism (IIG), an autonomous institute under the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, for scientific collaboration in the domain of space science, technology and exploration, on September 4, 2024. The event took place in ISRO Headquarters, Bengaluru, and was presided by Dr. Somanath S., Chairman, ISRO / Secretary, DOS. The MOU was signed by Shri Shantanu Bhatawdekar, Scientific Secretary, ISRO from the ISRO side, and Prof. A.P. Dimri, Director, IIG, from the IIG side. The witnesses were Dr. Tirtha Pratim Das, Director, Science Programme Office, ISRO Headquarters, Dr. Jagadheesha D, Deputy Director, Science Programme Office, ISRO Headquarters, Prof. S. Gurubaran, Professor, IIG, and Shri Ashutosh Shukla, Registrar, IIG. This collaboration will facilitate formulation of joint programme in the scientific understanding of the Sun-Earth connection, as well as exploration of space.



EOIR PAYLOAD ON EOS-08 BEGINS OPERATIONS, OFFERING EXCELLENT THERMAL IMAGING CAPABILITIES

The Electro Optical-Infrared (EOIR) payload on board EOS-08, ISRO's latest Earth Observation Satellite, launched through the third developmental flight of ISRO's Small Satellite Launch Vehicle (SSLV) on August 16, 2024, has commenced its operations (EOS-08 Mission). EOIR is a state-of-the-art payload aboard EOS-08, along with the Global Navigation Satellite System-Reflectometry (GNSS-R) payload and the SiC UV Dosimeter. Developed by the Space Applications Centre (SAC-ISRO), the EOIR payload is equipped with advanced mid-wave infrared (MIR) and long-wave infrared (LWIR) channels, marking a significant advancement in thermal imaging technology with its high performance.


